## Accreditation Update

On May 6-10, a team of five members of the American Association of Christian Schools (AACS) accreditation team came for a three-day visit to Fourth Baptist Christian School and a two-day visit to Woodcrest Baptist Academy.

The point of the visit to each school was to observe school operations based on the writing of the school's self-study. The self-study covered nine areas required in accreditation. These nine areas are as follows: Philosophy, Goals and Mission; Administration and School Improvement; Legal Structure, Policies, and Procedures;

Personnel; Fiscal Management; Curriculum, Pedagogy, and Assessment; Students, Parents and Community Relations; Facilities and Safety; and Special Services. The first draft of the report to each school has been read and corrections and adjustments have been requested. The finalization of the report and the final approval of accreditation will occur on June 26.

The exercise of accreditation was very beneficial in that it will identify for our schools the strengths and weaknesses of our programs. Should both schools receive an

## Legislative Update

With DFL control in both state houses and in the office of governor, private, religious schools are watching several points of legislation closely. There are three issues that we have been following closely throughout the past school year and they are as follows:



Race to the Top – Early Learning Grant – MACS schools stand against the acceptance of any daycare assistance funding or monies from Parent Aware. We continue to maintain contacts with the MN Dept. of Education to be included in reviewing the rewriting of the Early Childhood Indicators of Progress (ECIP's). Because of changes in the Early Learning office, we have lost our main contact. Karen Cadigan, Director of Early Learning, left the Department

initial five-year term of accreditation, a Self-Improvement Plan (SIP) will have to be written and will be due in September. In each successive year leading up to reaccreditation, the Self-Improvement Plan will have to be updated and reported to the accreditation commission. Included in the SIP will be the continuation of the writing of the curriculum guide with one subject needing to be completed each year, the continuation of training opportunities for our teachers, and the continuing requirement of licensing of our teachers with AACCS. New staff coming on board will have to fulfill licensing requirements as well.

Officially, the announcement Fourth Baptist and Woodcrest can share at this point is: "After completing a rigorous self-study process, [school name] hosted a team of educators for peer review on [date of visit]. The visiting team has unanimously recommended [school name] for full accreditation to the American Association of Christian Schools Accreditation Commission which will meet on June 26."

We are grateful for all the staff's hard work, parents and students who participated in the interviews, and the willingness of our peers to serve our school in the process of accreditation. Stay tuned for the end result...

the end of May. Melvin Carter, currently serving on the St. Paul City Council, is taking her place beginning in June. We will be attempting to set up a meeting with Mr. Carter very soon with the hopes of communicating the desire to maintain a good working relationship with his office. Your prayers to this end would be appreciated. As the ECIP's are rewritten, we have asked specifically, that several items be eliminated in the standards. Governor Dayton, in his education legislation passed in May, has really made an effort to fund all-day kindergarten and preschool education. The governor's agenda is to influence the lives of our children with the liberal agenda as early as possible. Wary of increasing attempts at government control over private preschool education, we continue to stress that our schools be very careful not to accept any government funding. Acceptance of government funding of any kind could result in the mandatory following of stipulations written in this and other

legislation. We fear that the battle is just beginning and we urge our members to pray that we might continue to be protected from government mandates in early education. The positive news is that there was a strong movement, prior to the session's end, to remove several of the ECIP's we strongly objected to. We will keep you posted.

Gay Marriage – As our state digresses morally, the effect upon an already struggling government educational system will be the result. By making gay marriage legal, the state, unknowingly, is increasing the potential dysfunction within our families. As the state continues to attack the security of the home and the institution of the family, we will continue to see an increase in the need for special education services statewide. Family stability is one of several keys to learning. We know that to be true in our schools. The real problem is not being addressed in our state and that is the need to work with our traditional families to create stable home environments. It is my conviction that a child needs

their mom and dad and they need both of them to be an active part of their lives. They need their homes to be stable places. As a culture, we continue to believe the lie that a family can be two homosexual partners. Several senators who corresponded with me tend to believe that homosexual partners can create stable families. But in the years to come we will see an increase in the struggles within an already taxed government educational system who can only see increased funding as an answer to a myriad of learning problems. This solution hasn't worked so far. We must create stability within our families and the only hope for real change and stability is the Gospel. This should cause us to really pray for our own communities and church families and try to create educational opportunities to work with our young married families. Even more, we need to be communicating the philosophy of our schools and teach people why a Christian education is so critical. Hopefully, families on the fringes watching closely, will begin to search out the truth as they find that the government system does not

have an answer for their children's education. I expect that we will see an increase in interest and applications this coming school year and in years to follow and pray that we will be able to serve a new and increasing constituency in our churches and schools who are searching for truth.

Safe and Supportive Minnesota Schools Act (Anti-bullying legislation) was not passed in the last session and will be taken up again in the 2014 legislative session. Prior to the end of the session, we were notified that there would be a private school exemption included in the Senate version which was not included before. We will keep a close watch on this in the coming months.

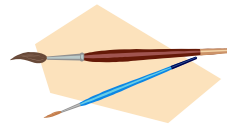
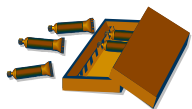
